2011 POOL SCHEDULE:

Pool opens

POOL RULES:

- 1. REGISTRATION:** Each MPS resident entering the pool area must show his or her membership tag to a MPS employee and sign the registration sheet.
- 2. LIMITED POOL MEMBERS:** Each LPM entering the pool for the first time of the season may pick up their Laminated Member Card. Thereafter, each LPM entering the pool must show their membership card to attendant on duty and sign the registration sheet.
- 3. GUESTS:** Five dollars (\$5.00) will be charged for each guest. No more than four guests will be allowed. The resident must accompany their guests to the pool.
- 4. RULES LIFEGUARDS MUST ENFORCE:**
 - Children under the age of 10 must have adult supervision at the pool.
 - NO RUNNING! NO DUNKING OR ROUGHHOUSING OF ANY KIND!**
 - No standing or sitting on shoulders, no "chicken fights", no throwing people into the air, etc.**
 - Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time and only one bounce.**
 - Dive straight off the board, and exit at the ladders - NEVER the sides of the pool. All diving from the sides of the pool MUST be done in the middle, roped part of the pool, in six (6) feet of water or more.**
 - Older children must play in the middle section of the pool, leaving the shallow end for small children.**
 - NO hand-held flotation devices (kickboards, noodles, etc.) in the deep end! If a child is to jump off the board with floaties, the parent or guardian MUST be in the water to catch them!!**
 - NO swimming in the diving area - not even off to the sides of the board!!**
 - NO diving in the shallow end of the pool.**
 - NO tennis balls - only soft, nerf-type balls. Children throwing balls must be in the pool, not on the deck.**
 - NO food or drink in the pool at any time.**
 - NO running on the pool deck; this includes when attempting to dive into the pool.**
 - NO flips off the side, back dives or other "tricks" off the side. Save them for the board!**
 - ALL swimmers under the age of 18 must clear the pool during adult swim. Small children (non-swimmers) may be in the water with adults. Children wanting to play catch at this time must exit the facility.**
 - NO cursing or foul language is permitted at any time.**
 - NO tobacco or alcohol of any kind in the pool area or on premises.**
 - NO glassware or glass containers permitted inside the pool area.**
- 5. PARENTS,** please supervise your small children! Our lifeguards are not babysitters. This includes the baby pool, bathrooms and big pool. We have had some close calls with little ones in the past and want to avoid those in the future.
- 6. RADIOS AND JAM BOXES:** A central radio, monitored by the lifeguard will be provided. The lifeguards must be able to hear all activity near the pool.
- 7. POOL TELEPHONE:** Frivolous use of the pool phone is prohibited.
